



DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

KARIE KUEHN #63,430
(the “Regulated Member”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
 (“CARNA”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Regulated Member and CARNA, dated with effect **August 13, 2020**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with CARNA, Karie Kuehn, #63,430 (the “Member”), acknowledged and admitted that her behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Member’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to CARNA include the following:

- The Member discharged a child patient from the hospital with an intravenous cannula *in situ* without a physician’s order;
- The Member exceeded appropriate professional boundaries when they inserted an intravenous cannula into their adult family member, outside the scope of their practice;

The Member agreed to complete coursework on Professional Boundaries and complete a 2000 word essay. The Member’s employer will also provide two (2) Performance Evaluations covering 250 hours of nursing practice each. Conditions shall appear on the CARNA register and on the Member’s practice permit.
