

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

FIONA LYNNE, #111,135
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect June 7, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, FIONA LYNNE, #111,135 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- On or about January 9, 2024, the Registrant failed to uphold medication administration standards when they did one (1) or more of the following:
 - Prepared narcotics and failed to ensure that they were administered in a timely manner;
 - Left open narcotics containers unattended on an unlocked med cart;
 - Left without counting the narcotics; and
 - The Registrant failed to document the narcotics taken adequately on the narcotics sheet.
- On or about January 9, 2024, the Registrant failed to demonstrate reasonable judgment when they breached confidentiality of an employer investigation.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work on medication management and professionalism and provide a behavior improvement plan. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
