



DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

JACQUELINE SANFORD #37,370
(the “**Regulated Member**”)

and

The College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
 (“**CARNA**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Regulated Member and CARNA, dated with effect **JUNE 3, 2021**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with CARNA, JACQUELINE SANFORD, #37,370 (the “**Regulated Member**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Regulated Member’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to CARNA and includes the following:

- The Regulated Member, while in the role on a Clinical Nurse Educator, failed to use critical inquiry and failed to adequately collaborate with the other members of the healthcare team about the care of a patient, who was suffering critical post-partum hemorrhaging, including when they administered rocuronium to the patient.
- The Regulated Member failed to maintain sterility of the Operating Room and failed to be accountable for infection prevention and control when they failed to don scrubs, as required, and entered the Operating Room in personal street clothes and capri pants with bare legs and a sterile gown overtop during a caesarian delivery and communicated with other members of the healthcare team in a manner that could be perceived as inappropriate after entering the Operating Room.

The Regulated Member agreed to complete course work and provide practice report letters covering six months of nursing practice. Conditions shall appear on the CARNA register and on the Regulated Member’s practice permit.
