

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

GEORGE TAABAZUING, #126,713
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect September 10, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, George Taabazuing, #126,713 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College and includes the following:

- On or around September 27, 2023, the Registrant failed to disclose during an attestation for renewal that he was registered with the Nursing and Midwifery Council (UK) and had conditions on his license in that jurisdiction, and consequently did not meet the good character requirements of the College of Registered Nurses of Alberta.

The Registrant agreed to pay a fine and requested that the Registrar remove their name from the register of the College. As a result, the Registrant’s registration and practice permit are rescinded.
