

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

LINDSAY CROOK, #82,344
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect November 14, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, LINDSAY CROOK, #82,344 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from five (5) complaints to the College and includes the following:

- On or about between May 22 and September 25, 2023, the Registrant demonstrated a lack of skill and/or judgment in their care of patients when, they did one (1) or more of the following:
 - Failed to adequately assess vital signs on one (1) or more patient and/or falsified documentation on the vital signs on one (1) or more occasion;
 - On one or more occasion failed to adequately perform and/or document a comprehensive triage assessment; and
 - On one or more occasion altered CTAS scores in violation of one (1) or more employer policies.

The Registrant agreed to course work on documentation and health assessment and provide an eight hundred (800) word behavior improvement plan. The Registrant further agreed to provide two practice report letters covering a total of 480 nursing practice hours. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
