

# **DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT**

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**SOHAN (SUE) MA, #90,654**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
**also known as College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **MARCH 1, 2022**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, SOHAN MA, #90-654 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- The Registrant failed to respect a patient’s decision and right to revoke consent, and failed to demonstrate reasonable judgment when, on one (1) occasion, they did not stop administering a MRSA swab to a patient after the patient revoked consent.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework and write a paper on the importance of obtaining patient consent. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
